Production of RDF from industrial waste

The company was established in 1952 as a waste collector. It developed also in septic tank maintenance business, and in the waste recycling business in 1981.

RDF (refuse-derived fuel) is an established scheme of « waste to energy » concept. The produced RDF has a constant thermal value (about 6000 kcal/kg) with low chlorine content of 0.2 to 0.8%. The produced RDF has a size of 35mm in diameter and 70mm in length. RDF produced less ash than coal, and the ash can be used in cement industry.
