1. Program Objective:

Help nurture the next generation of leaders by inviting foreign and Japanese high school students to discuss global peace, share ideas, deepen mutual understanding, and spread a message of peace around the world.

3. **Dates** August 15 (Sat) to 19 (Wed), 2026

4. **Location** International Conference Center Hiroshima
(1-5 Nakajima-cho, Naka-ku, Hiroshima City, Hiroshima Pref.)

5. **Theme** How we can contribute to achieving a peaceful world without nuclear weapons

7. **Participation fee:** Free

8. Costs covered by the sponsors:

- Transportation from residence to the venue
- Lodging in Hiroshima City: 4 - 6 nights (August 14 or 15 to 18 or 19)
**In principle, students living within or near Hiroshima city will commute from their residence every day. However, if it is difficult to return home or arrive in time for the program without staying overnight, lodging fee may be covered.*
- Conference costs, printing costs, tours (admission fees, charter bus costs, etc.), meals during the program (including the welcome reception)

**Accommodation and meals will be arranged and provided by the sponsors.*

9. Number of participants:

- International high school students (those living in Japan & living overseas) approx. 40 people
- Japanese high school students approx. 45 people

10. Application period:

Applications must be received by **May 31 (Sun), 2026 11:59 pm (Japan Standard Time).**

11. Application requirements:

- (1) Youths 15 to 18 years old (high school students)
- (2) Highly interested in realizing international peace (the abolition of nuclear weapons etc.)
- (3) Can actively participate in English discussions
- (4) Can join in group activities according to the program
- (5) Can attend the entire program including the pre-learning program
- (6) Highly motivated to make use of the experiences of this program to participate in peace activities, including international exchanges, local community initiatives, and posting on social media, etc.
